Webster City Community Theatre Endowed Scholarship 2020

Webster City Community Theatre is an organization of theatre amateurs who desire to bring the residents of this community in contact with theatre and opportunities to be a part of the theatre world. WCCT offers financial assistance to students who have participated in the theatre arts and who may be interested in receiving further education in that field; however, a theatre arts major is not required to qualify for the scholarship.

Webster City Community Theatre annually presents one or more scholarships of \$500 to a graduate or graduating senior. The applicant must have been active in the theatre arts in his or her school or community. Preference will be given to applicants who were involved in WCCT productions. Preference will also be given to students pursuing careers in the arts, particularly performance arts.

Scholarship Procedures and Guidelines

A review board appointed by the Webster City Community Theatre board of directors will consider all complete applications submitted prior to the deadline. The selection of the scholarship recipient(s) is left entirely to this board. The review board's final decision will be announced in an appropriate manner, such as at the awards assembly at the end of the school year.

Application Requirements:

- The applicant must be a resident of a school district serving Hamilton County (or a neighboring county if active in past WCCT productions).
- The applicant must have a "C" average or better during high school or college career.
- The applicant must be admitted to or enrolled in an accredited two- or four-year college.
- The applicant must provide three letters of reference from individuals who can attest to their academic achievements, theatre arts activities and accomplishments, and/or other information which supports their scholarship application.
- The applicant must submit a list of participation and/or accomplishments in theatre-related activities.
- Completed applications must be *received* by Webster City Community Theatre, via personal delivery or by mail to P.O. Box 272, Webster City, IA 50595, no later than May 1st.
